#### Letter from the Rector

**Creationtide**, or the Season of Creation, is the period in the annual church calendar, from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 4<sup>th</sup> October, dedicated to God as Creator and Sustainer of all life. Within this period, All Saints, like many churches, holds a Harvest Festival to give thanks for God's gift of creation, and to renew our commitment to caring for the planet we call home.

The Church of England's theme for the Season of Creation 2023 is *Let Justice and Peace Flow*. The prophet Isaiah proclaims: "Listen carefully, I am about to do a new thing, now it will spring forth; will you not be aware of it? I will even put a road in the wilderness, rivers in the desert."

(Isaiah 43: 19)

Biodiversity is being lost at a rate not seen since the last mass extinction. The futures of young people are threatened by the cascading impacts of the loss of this biodiversity and a changing climate.
