A Marathon in a Week

Since lock down the Samaritans, like all charities, have been suffering serious loss of income as they are not able to carry out their normal fundraising activities. They are classed as an essential organisation by the government and are needed more than ever during these days of self-isolation with a rise in loneliness, mental health issues, increased domestic abuse etc. My partner, John Crouch, continues to do his shifts and so is in the front line trying to help people through these issues.

I have had an idea to raise some money.

Since I did my 1st triathlon in 2017, I have continued to run about twice a week. This takes place between 06:15 and 07:30 hrs around Barwick village.

In the week around 26th April I intend to increase this to 4 or 5 times in that 7 day period so the accumulated mileage will be 26.2 miles – a marathon. I appreciate that this is not a huge challenge but this will be my exercise allowance for the day, the circuit I use will never take me more than a mile from home and social distancing is not an issue at that time in the morning so I will be complying with government requirements.

'Dial in' worship time twice a week held at 10am on Sundays and Wednesdays.

To join the service

Dial in using the appropriate number

from a Landline: 0844 4 73 73 73 or from a UK Mobile: 8 73 73

When asked, enter the group PIN 716 416.

You'll be asked to record your name and then the conference call can begin.

The phone calls last around 20 – 30 mins on a Sunday and 15 mins on a Wednesday.

The call costs

5.8p/min from a landline +VAT and your phone company's access charge.

12.5p/min from a mobile +VAT. If you are unable to call this number and are using an O2 mobile, please dial 98 73 73 instead.

We estimate the cost will be just over £2 on Sunday and £1 on Wednesday.

Please check with your phone provider for their additional charges.
