2nd Apr - Palm Sunday -

Joint Holy Communion with Anglicans and Methodists.

For those who wish to process across -
the service starts in the Methodist church.

For those who do not want to walk across -
the service starts in All Saints'.

In both churches

- ◇ please collect a palm cross at the door
- ◇ the service starts with some liturgy and a reading
(from the red booklets in the Methodist church,
on the screen in All Saints')
- ◇ then a hymn, part way through the hymn the people
in the Methodist church start to walk across
- ◇ they stop for prayers
- ◇ then finish the hymn and walk into All Saints'
- ◇ when everyone has arrived hymn 2 is sung

The service continues on slides.

There will be both consecrated non-alcoholic wine and
consecrated alcoholic wine available during communion.
Gluten free wafers will also be available.
